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CONDITIONAL PARDON

CIVITELLO, JOHN ALAN. Sentenced November 30, 1979, in the Circuit Court of Chesapeake upon a conviction of Possession of Schedule 1 Controlled Drug, Marijuana, with intent to distribute and sentenced to seven years. Chapter 435 of the 1979 Acts of Assembly reduces the penalty for certain criminal offenses involving the possession, manufacture, cultivation, distribution or sale of Marijuana, and there are certain inmates presently confined within the Virginia Department of Corrections who are serving sentences which exceed the maximum sentences which could be imposed pursuant to Chapter 435. It appears to me that John Alan Civitello, No. 119865, is such an inmate; and in the absence of Executive Clemency such inmates would receive no benefit from Chapter Therefore, I am granting John Alan Civitello, No. 119865, a Conditional Pardon for the conviction herein named and do order that he be relieved of any unserved sentence which exceeds twelve months and a fine of one thousand dollars, either or both, and upon the condition that he be placed under the supervision of the Virginia Parole Board for a period of two years, to commence upon his release from incarceration. If at any time prior to the date of his release from the pardon conditions he be found guilty of violation of the penal laws of any city, county, State or of the United States, this pardon may be revoked. The pardon granted hereby shall have no effect on any other sentence which the said John Alan Civitello, No. 119865, is serving or which he may have to serve in the future. This pardon dated February 25, 1981.

McKOWN, CORA ERNESTINE DEAN. Sentenced August 1, 1969, in the Circuit Court of Chesapeake upon a conviction of First-degree Murder and sentenced to life imprisonment. In view of this woman's outstanding achievements and record during her incarceration, and upon the recommendations of officials within the Department of Corrections, as well as the community support, I am granting Cora Ernestine Dean McKown, VSP No. 93237, a Conditional Pardon, and am ordering that she be placed under the supervision of the Virginia Parole Board for a period of ten years from this date. This pardon dated January 8, 1982.

PANNELL, JAMES, aka Abdulsaleem Ahmad. Sentenced March 22, 1968, in the Hustings Court of Roanoke upon a conviction of Rape and sentenced to life imprisonment; and on July 19, 1978, in the Circuit Court of Richmond upon a conviction of Escape at which time imposition of sentence was suspended. In view of Subject's splendid adjustment since his voluntary return from Escape, the strong family and community support from both within and without the State, and the unanimous recommendation by the Parole Board, I am granting James Pannell, aka Abdulsaleem Ahmad, VSP No. 90951, a Conditional Pardon and am ordering that he placed under the supervision of the Virginia Parole Board for a period of ten years from this date. This pardon dated April 29, 1981.

PANNELL, LARRY JEROME. Sentenced March 4, 1968, in the Hustings Court of Roanoke upon a conviction of Rape and sentenced to life imprisonment; and on November 5, 1976, in the Circuit Court of Southampton County upon a conviction of Escape and sentenced to two years. In view of Subject's excellent adjustment since his return from escape,

the strong family and community support and the recommendations of the Parole Board, I am granting Larry Jerome Pannell, VSP No. 90840, a Conditional Pardon and am ordering that he be placed under the supervision of the Virginia Parole Board for a period of ten years from this date. This pardon dated January 8, 1982.

PARDON TO OWN, POSSESS AND TRANSPORT IN COMMERCE A FIREARM

COURNOW, WILLIAM MARVIN. Sentenced July 28, 1965, in the Circuit Court of Chesterfield County upon a conviction of Armed Robbery and sentenced to five years with three years suspended. In order for this individual to qualify for Federal permission to own, possess and transport a firearm, and there being no objection on the part of the present Commonwealth's Attorney of Chesterfield County, I am granting him a Pardon to Own, Possess and Transport in Commerce a Firearm. This pardon dated May 29, 1981.

HUNDLEY, WALTER LEWIS. Sentenced December 17, 1971, in the Circuit Court of Westmoreland County upon a conviction of Unlawful wounding and sentenced to twelve months in jail with six months suspended and placed on probation for two years. This individual is a commercial fisherman and because this occupation is seasonal in nature, it is necessary for him to supplement his food sources by other means. Therefore, in view of the recommendations of members of the Virginia Congressional Delegation, the Sheriff of Westmoreland County, the Commonwealth's Attorney of Prince William County, and the sentencing Judge not objecting, I am granting him a Pardon to Own, Possess and Transport in Commerce a Firearm. This pardon dated May 29, 1981.

PARDON WITHOUT CONDITIONS

CLARK. ROYAL CLINTON. Sentenced June 18, 1975, in the Circuit Court of Richmond upon a conviction of Robbery and sentenced to ten years, Robbery and sentenced to fifteen years with ten years suspended, two counts of Armed Robbery and sentenced to five years each count, and Maiming and sentenced to fifteen years; and on May 4, 1977, in the Circuit Court of Richmond, he was convicted of Second Conviction and sentenced to five years with four years suspended. In view of this man's life expectancy due to terminal lung cancer, and based upon the recommendation of the Parole Board, the sentencing Judge not objecting and the Commonwealth's Attorney not wishing to take a position, I am granting Royal Clinton Clark a Pardon Without Conditions, subject to his good behavior for two years. Furthermore, I hereby order that he be released forthwith from confinement. This pardon dated March 13, 1981.

GORMUS, PAUL IRVING. Sentenced March 26, 1980, in the Circuit Court of Richmond upon a conviction of Statutory burglary and sentenced to three years, and of Grand larceny and sentenced to three years to run concurrent; on May 22, 1980, in the Circuit Court of Chesterfield County upon a conviction of Breaking and entering and sentenced to five years with four years suspended for twenty years; and on July 1, 1980, in the Circuit Court of Chesterfield County of Statutory burglary

and sentenced to ten years with nine years suspended for ten years. In view of the life expectancy of this individual and upon the recommendation of the Parole Board, the sentencing Judges and prosecuting Commonwealth's Attorneys having no objection, I am granting Paul Irving Gormus, No. 120561, a Pardon Without Conditions, subject to his good behavior, and am ordering that he be released forthwith from confinement.

THOMASSON, JOHN EDWARD. Sentenced November 15, 1967, in the Circuit Court of Mecklenburg County upon a conviction of Statutory burglary and sentenced to ten years; on December 15, 1967, in the Circuit Court of Brunswick County upon a conviction of Grand larceny and sentenced to one year to run concurrent; on January 26, 1968, in the Circuit Court of Halifax County upon a conviction of Breaking and entering and sentenced to four years; on March 11, 1968, in the Corporation Court of Danville upon a conviction of five counts of Statutory burglary and sentenced to two years each count to run concurrent with Count 1 of the Indictment; on February 11, 1969, in the Circuit Court of Campbell County upon a conviction of Statutory burglary and sentenced to one year; on February 20, 1970, in the Corporation Court of Martinsville upon a conviction of Breaking and entering and sentenced to three years, and of Grand larcenv and sentenced to five years; on July 6, 1970, in the Circuit Court of Pittsylvania County upon a conviction of five counts of Statutory burglary and sentenced to one year on each count with four years to run concurrent; and on October 19, 1970, in the Circuit Court of Henry County upon a conviction of eight counts of Breaking and entering and sentenced to two years on each count with eight years to run concurrent. A Conditional Pardon was granted April 18, 1975, with parole supervision being terminated April 18, 1979; however, the remaining conditions of Pardon were to remain in full force and effect until March 19, 1991. In view of this man's excellent adjustment since his release and the fact that he is in declining health due to kidney failure which requires dialysis treatment, and based upon the unanimous recommendation of the Parole Board, I am granting this individual a Pardon Without Conditions. This pardon dated January 20, 1981.

SIMPLE PARDON

AIKINS, WILLIAM ROBERT, JR. Sentenced February 24, 1978, in the Circuit Court of Nottoway County upon a conviction of Possession with intent to distribute Schedule I controlled substance - Marijuana, Possession with intent to distribute Schedule II controlled substance - Cocaine, and Possession with intent to distribute Schedule I controlled substance - LSD, and sentenced to five years each count to run concurrent and suspended upon his good behavior for four years; and on January 4, 1979, in the Circuit Court of Danville upon a conviction of two counts of Selling Marijuana as an Accommodation and sentenced to six months and fined \$100 on Count 1, and twelve months with six months suspended upon his good behavior for one year from release and fined \$200 on Count 2. On June 20, 1979, twelve months of the sentence imposed on February 24, 1978, was revoked. On November 15, 1979, the revocation order of June 20, 1979, was amended and the unserved portion of the twelve-month revocation was suspended upon his good behavior for four

years from February 24, 1978, and he was placed on probation for four years. In view of the facts as presented to me and the community support given to this individual, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 15, 1982.

ALTICE, HENRY LEE. Sentenced June 13, 1973, in the Circuit Court of Franklin County upon a conviction of Distribute LSD and sentenced to twenty years with twelve years suspended for ten years upon release, and of Aiding and abetting in unlawful distribution of Marijuana and sentenced to twenty years with twelve years suspended for ten years upon release, to run concurrent; and on July 24, 1973, in the Circuit Court of Roanoke City of Distribution of Hashish and sentenced to five years suspended after serving eighteen months, and of Possession of Heroin and sentenced to two years suspended after serving one year to run concurrent with the Distribution of Hashish conviction. In view of this man's achievements since his release, the recommendation of the Parole Board, and the sentencing Judge of Roanoke City not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 8, 1982.

ARMENTROUT, JESSE DILLON, JR. Sentenced February 21, 1972, in the Circuit Court of Rockingham County upon a conviction of Statutory burglary and sentenced to two years, Attempted murder and sentenced to three years, and Robbery and sentenced to five years. In view of this man's accomplishments since his release, the recommendation of the Parole Board and the sentencing Judge having no objection, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 8, 1982.

BECK, CONSTANCE ELIZABETH CROMWELL, aka Constance Elizabeth Flanders. Sentenced September 30, 1970, in the Corporation Court of Norfolk upon a conviction of Forgery, Uttering and Petit larceny at which time imposition of sentence was suspended and she was placed on probation for three years. In view of this woman's achievements since her conviction, the recommendation of the Parole Board, the sentencing Judge and Commonwealth's Attorney not objecting, I am granting her a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated November 10, 1981.

BUCHANAN, ALICE HARPER. Sentenced November 11, 1976, in the Circuit Court of Rockbridge County upon a conviction of Embezzlement and fined \$500. In view of the facts as presented to me wherein it appears that justice has been served, I am granting her a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 11, 1982.

BYRNES, JOHN MITCHELL. Sentenced August 20, 1970, in the Circuit Court of Fairfax County upon a conviction of Burglary and sentenced to five years suspended and placed on probation for two years. In view of this man's excellent achievements since his conviction, the Parole Board unanimously recommending and the sentencing Judge not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated July 30, 1981.

COURNOW, WILLIAM MARVIN. Sentenced July 28, 1965, in the Circuit Court of Chesterfield County upon a conviction of Armed Robbery and sentenced to five years with three years suspended. In view of this man's contributions to his community since his release and the excellent manner in which he has rehabilitated himself, the Parole Board and present Commonwealth's Attorney of Chesterfield County recommending, the sentencing Judge being deceased, and the support of law enforcement officials, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated May 29, 1981.

DEAL, JAMES REUBEN. Sentenced September 15, 1953, in the Circuit Court of Mathews County upon a conviction of two counts of Grand larceny and sentenced to four years with two years to run concurrent; on November 2, 1953, in the Circuit Court of Gloucester County upon a conviction of five counts of Breaking and entering and sentenced to thirty-five years with five years to run concurrent, and three counts of Grand larceny and sentenced to six years with two years to run concurrent; on November 2, 1953, in the Circuit Court of Middlesex County upon a conviction of two counts of Breaking and entering and sentenced to twelve years with ten years to run concurrent; on November 21, 1953, in the Circuit Court of Warwick City upon a conviction of Housebreaking and sentenced to three years to run concurrent; on November 23, 1953, in the Circuit Court of York County upon a conviction of two counts of Breaking and entering and sentenced to two years each count to run concurrent with each other; and on December 14, 1953, in the Circuit Court of Goochland County upon a conviction of two counts of Breaking and entering and sentenced to ten years to run concurrent. He was paroled October 7, 1964, and discharged July 17, 1972. In view of this man's accomplishments since his release and his contribution to his community, the recommendations of the Parole Board and sentencing officials, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated December 17, 1981.

EIERMAN, STEVEN JOHN. Sentenced May 26, 1974, in the Circuit Court of Lynchburg upon a conviction of Distribution of LSD for Accommodation and sentenced to two years with one year suspended and placed on probation for two years upon his release from confinement. In view of this man's achievements since his release, the recommendation of the Parole Board, the sentencing Judge not objecting and the prosecuting and current Commonwealth's Attorneys deferring judgment, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated November 10, 1981.

FONT, JORGE ANTONIO. Sentenced March 3, 1978, in the Circuit Court of Fairfax County upon a conviction of Distributing a controlled drug as an accommodation, Cocaine, and sentenced to two years suspended and placed on probation for two years. In view of this man's accomplishments since his conviction and the community support, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 12, 1982.

FORD, WILLIAM J. Sentenced September 24, 1979, in the General District Court of Chesapeake upon a conviction of Larceny of a meter and fined \$20; and on September 26, 1979, in the General District Court of Suffolk upon a conviction of Tampering with a meter and fined

\$50. In view of the information which has been brought to my attention and the fact that the ends of justice have been served, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 8, 1982.

GREENE, JAMES DALE. Sentenced April 3, 1975, in the Circuit Court of Virginia Beach upon a conviction of Forgery and sentenced to five years suspended upon his good behavior for five years. In view of this man's achievements since his conviction, the unanimous recommendation of the Parole Board and the sentencing Judge not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 6, 1982.

HUTCHERSON, VIRGINIA PEYTON, now Virginia Hutcherson Curd. Sentenced March 22, 1973, in the Circuit Court of Roanoke City upon a conviction of Uttering and two counts of Forgery and Uttering and sentenced to six months each count suspended and placed on probation for three years. In view of this woman's accomplishments since her conviction, the recommendation of the Parole Board and community support, I am granting her a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 11, 1982.

JONES, EDWARD AVERETTE. Sentenced November 5, 1975, in the Circuit Court of Charlotte County upon a conviction of four counts of Grand larceny and sentenced to twelve months on each of Counts 2 and 4, and to twelve months suspended and placed on probation for three years on each of Counts 1 and 3. In view of the excellent rehabilitative progress this individual has undertaken since his release, the recommendations of the Parole Board, the sentencing Judge and Commonwealth's Attorney I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated August 12, 1981.

JONES, HOYT DEMPSEY. Sentenced November 5, 1975, in the Circuit Court of Charlotte County upon a conviction of two counts of Grand larceny and sentenced to twelve months on Count 1, and twelve months suspended for three years on Count 2. In view of the excellent rehabilitative progress this individual has undertaken since his release, the recommendations of the Parole Board, the sentencing Judge and the Commonwealth's Attorney, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated August 12, 1981.

JOYCE, EDDIE MILTON. Sentenced August 29, 1975, in the Circuit Court of Roanoke County upon a conviction of Grand larceny and sentenced to thirty days in jail and fined \$1,000. In view of the recommendation of the Parole Board, the community support, and the sentencing Judge not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 7, 1982.

KINGERY, LONZA EDWARD. Sentenced February 25, 1963, in the Hustings Court of Roanoke City upon a conviction of Petit larceny and sentenced to twelve months in jail suspended and fined \$25. Based on this individual's excellent rehabilitation since his conviction and the prominent position he holds in his community, the recommendation of the Parole Board, the current Judge voicing no objection and the present Commonwealth's Attorney remaining neutral, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated May 8, 1981.

LANGMAID, GREGORY C. Sentenced August 18, 1976, in the General District Court of Fairfax County upon a conviction of Petit larceny and sentenced to six months suspended. In view of this man's excellent rehabilitation since his conviction, the unanimous recommendation of the Parole Board, and the sentencing Judge voicing no objection, the Commonwealth's Attorney not responding, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated June 12, 1981.

MORAN, JONATHAN JOHN, aka Jonathan Kirk Moran. Sentenced March 3, 1970, in the Corporation Court of Alexandria upon a conviction of Illegal sale of narcotics at which time imposition of sentence was suspended and he was placed on probation for five years. On January 21, 1971, three years of the suspension was revoked. In view of this man's excellent rehabilitative progress since his release, the recommendation of the Parole Board, and the sentencing Judge not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated September 1, 1981.

NEAL, POLK MILLER, JR. Sentenced June 1, 1971, in the Hustings Court of Richmond upon a conviction of Maliciously destroying property and sentenced to three years suspended for five years and ordered to make restitution. In view of this man's achievements since his conviction, the unanimous recommendation of the Parole Board and the sentencing officials not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 7, 1982.

POOLE, MARTIN ETHERIDGE. Sentenced October 15, 1953, in the Corporation Court of Norfolk, Part II, upon a conviction of Statutory burglary and sentenced to two years. In view of this man's accomplishments since his release, and the recommendation of the Parole Board, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 11, 1982.

RICHARD, EARL. Sentenced January 24, 1952, in the Corporation Court of Norfolk upon a conviction of Attempt to commit larceny at which time imposition of sentence was suspended. On February 15, 1954, his suspension was revoked and he was ordered to serve six months in jail. In view of this individual's accomplishments since his conviction, and community support, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 8, 1982.

RUBINGER, GERALD. Sentenced January 12, 1979, in the Circuit Court of Virginia Beach upon a conviction of Bribery of witnesses and fined \$1,000. In view of this man's achievements since his conviction, the community support and the sentencing Judge not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 7, 1982.

SANDS, CHRISTOPHER ANDREW. Sentenced February 7, 1971, in the General District Court of Fairfax County upon a conviction of Concealment of Merchandise at which time imposition of sentence was suspended for one year. In view of this man's achievements since his conviction and upon the recommendations of the Parole Board and the sentencing Judge, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated December 17, 1981.

SHOTWELL, WILLIAM ALLEN. Sentenced July 27, 1968, in the Circuit Court of Arlington County upon a conviction of Possession of Marijuana and sentenced to three years suspended and placed on probation for three years. In view of the excellent rehabilitative progress this individual has undertaken since his release, the recommendations of the Parole Board and the sentencing Judge, the current Commonwealth's Attorney not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated August 12, 1981.

WARREN, DWAIN CORNELIUS. Sentenced December 14, 1973, in the General District Court of Norfolk upon a conviction of Sale of Marijuana and sentenced to one year in jail suspended and fined \$250. In view of this man's accomplishments since his conviction, the unanimous recommendation of the Parole Board, and the sentencing officials not objecting, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated January 11, 1982.

WARSING, JERRY WOODROW. Sentenced July 19, 1963, in the Corporation Court of Norfolk upon a conviction of Burglary and Grand larceny and sentenced to three years suspended and placed on probation for three years. His suspension and probation expired July 19, 1966. Based upon this individual's excellent rehabilitation since his conviction and the prominent position he holds in his community, the recommendation of the Parole Board, and there being no objection on the part of sentencing officials, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated May 8, 1981.

WISE, CRAIG DORSEY. Sentenced May 24, 1968, in the Hustings Court of Richmond upon a conviction of Petit larceny and sentenced to twelve months in jail suspended upon his good behavior for two years and fined \$200; and on October 29, 1970, in the Circuit Court of Hampton upon a conviction of Possession of Marijuana and sentenced to three years suspended for one year and fined \$500. In view of this man's accomplishments since his convictions, and upon the recommendation of the Parole Board, the sentencing officials not voicing any objections, I am granting him a Simple Pardon. This pardon dated December 18, 1981.

REMOVAL OF POLITICAL DISABILITIES

Relying on the recommendations of parole officers and reputable citizens who are familiar with the conduct of these individuals since their conviction or release, I have granted Removal of Political Disabilities to the following:

ABBOTT, TIMOTHY CLAY. Sentenced September 3, 1976, in the Circuit Court of Roanoke County upon a conviction of Distribution of a Controlled Schedule 1 Substance and sentenced to ten years suspended after serving three years, to be served concurrently with any other sentence imposed by any other Court; and sentenced January 27, 1977, and amended May 13, 1977, in the Circuit Court of Bedford County upon a conviction of Two counts of Distribution of a Controlled Substance and sentenced to five years each count suspended, to serve six months each count and placed on unsupervised probation for 4 years from date

of conviction; and sentenced February 2, 1977, in the Circuit Court of Roanoke City upon a conviction of Distribution of Marijuana and sentenced to five years suspended to run concurrent with any other conviction and fined \$396. Paroled April 9, 1977, and discharged April 9, 1979. Probation expired January 27, 1981, and suspension terminated August 1, 1981. Court costs have been paid. Granted removal of political disabilities on September 1, 1981.

AIKINS, WILLIAM ROBERT, JR. Sentenced February 24, 1978, Revoked June 20, 1979, and Amended November 15, 1979,, in the Circuit Court of Nottoway County upon a conviction of Possession with intent to distribute Schedule II controlled substance and Two counts of Possession with intent to distribute Schedule I controlledsubstance and sentenced to five years each count to run concurrent, suspended upon good behavior for four years. Twelve months of sentence revoked June 20, 1979, and on November 15, 1979, revocation order of June 20, 1979, was amended and the unserved portion of the twelve-month revocation was suspended upon his good behavior for four years from February 24, 1978, and he was placed on probation; and sentenced January 4, 1979, in the Circuit Court of Danville City upon a conviction of Two counts of Selling Marijuana as an accommodation and sentenced to six months and fined \$100 on Count 1, and twelve months with six months suspended upon good behavior for one year from release and fined \$200 on Count 2. Fines and court costs have been paid. Granted removal of political disabilities on January 15, 1982.

ALBERT, JACK HUFFORD, JR., aka Jack H. Albert, Jr. Sentenced April 25, 1978, in the Circuit Court of Warren County upon a conviction of Grand larceny by embezzlement and sentenced to three years, to serve sixty days with remaining sentence suspended and probation for three years. Suspension and probation expired May 23, 1981, and court costs have been paid. Granted removal of political disabilities on August 14, 1981.

ALLEN, EDWARD BERNARD. Sentenced March 12, 1975, in the United States District Court, Eastern District of Virginia, Norfolk, upon a conviction of Violation of Title 18, USC, Section 1623, and sentenced to three years suspended, placed on probation for three years and fined \$2,000. Suspension and probation terminated December 30, 1975, and fine has been paid. Granted removal of political disabilities on December 23, 1981.

ALLISON, PHILLIP JEFFERY. Sentenced June 16, 1977, and Amended August 30, 1977, in the Circuit Court of Washington County upon a conviction of Distribute Controlled Drug and sentenced to five years suspended after serving six months and placed on probation for five years. SNEAD, WILBUR AUBREY. Sentenced January 11, 1978, in the Circuit Court of Albemarle County upon a conviction of Possession with intent to distribute Marijuana and sentenced to five years suspended for five years and placed on probation for one year. Probation expired January 11, 1979, and suspension terminated November 18, 1981. Court costs have been paid. Granted removal of political disabilities on December 30, 1981.

SOUTHWORTH, BEATRICE OWENS. Sentenced August 21, 1978, in the Circuit Court of Martinsville upon a conviction of Embezzlement and sentenced to twelve months in jail suspended, placed on probation for two years, and fined \$500. Probation was terminated by Court Order March 10, 1980, and suspension expired November 21, 1980. Restitution, fine and court costs have been paid. Granted removal of political disabilities on February 4, 1981.

SOWERS, LUTHER ALVIN.
