Based on the fact that Alex Manuel Velazquez had been diagnosed in late 1990 as positive for Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and his condition had deteriorated to the point that his prognosis for recovery was questionable, his request for clemency was submitted to a review process which utilizes an Assessment Committee and the Parole Board. I created this process to review all requests for clemency which are based upon allegations of fatal illnesses.

Upon recommendation of the Assessment Committee and the Parole Board and in view of the facts that revealed that the medical condition of Alex Manuel Velazquez had deteriorated to the point where advising physicians could not assure that he would survive beyond a three month period; his prison record was exemplary; he was scheduled for discretionary parole relief on June 8, 1993; the Parole Board had voted to release him on that date; and the Parole Board had coordinated with the New York City Parole Board the potential release of Alex Manuel Velazquez to its jurisdiction if he were granted conditional clemency, the Governor granted Alex Manuel Velazquez a conditional pardon in the form of a Medical Furlough effective until his release by the Virginia Parole Board on June 8, 1993.

Based on the fact that Patricia Mae Dillard had been diagnosed as positive for Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and her condition had deteriorated to the point that her prognosis for recovery was questionable, her request for clemency was submitted to a review process which utilizes an Assessment Committee and the Parole Board. I created this process to review all requests for clemency which are based upon allegations of fatal illnesses.

Upon recommendation of the Assessment Committee and the Parole Board and in view of the facts that revealed that the medical condition of Patricia Mae Dillard had deteriorated to the point where advising physicians could not assure that she would survive beyond a three month period; she had received favorable personal conduct evaluations; and she had successfully participated in educational and treatment programs, the Governor granted Patricia Mae Dillard a conditional pardon in the form of a Medical Furlough under the supervision of the Virginia Parole Board effective until she is released on discretionary or mandatory parole by the Virginia Parole Board.

On August 22, 1980, Herbert Russell Bassette, was found guilty of the murder and robbery of Albert Lee Burwell, Jr. and the jury fixed his punishment at death. On November 19, 1980, Judge Robert M. Wallace accepted the jury's judgment and entered an order sentencing Herbert Russell Bassette to death.

It is axiomatic that the ultimate sentence of death must be applied solely to those who have been demonstrated beyond a reasonable doubt to have committed the crimes for which they are charged. After a thorough review of the evidence, including evidence presented by counsel for Herbert Russell Bassette which was not before the jury when they rendered their verdict, the Governor could not in good conscience erase the presence of a reasonable doubt and fail to employ the powers vested in him as Governor to intervene. Therefore, in light of the foregoing the Governor granted Herbert Russell Bassette a commutation of sentence of death to life imprisonment without parole.

On November 17, 1978, Charles Sylvester Stamper, was found guilty of three counts of capital murder, three counts of use of a firearm in the commission of a felony and one count of armed robbery. The jury fixed his sentence at death by electrocution for each count of capital murder, one year in prison for each count of use firearm in the commission of a felony and life imprisonment for armed robbery. On February 9, 1979, Judge E. Ballard Baker entered judgment, confirming the jury's sentence.

On September 2, 1992, Judge Lee A Harris, Jr., Judge of the Circuit Court of Henrico County, set the date of execution of Charles Sylvester Stamper for October 28, 1992.

Counsel for Charles Sylvester Stamper petitioned the Governor to commute the sentence entered by the court to life imprisonment on the grounds of mercy. In support of this request counsel assembled information and reports which evidenced that Charles Sylvester Stamper suffers from a spinal cord injury that was sustained after he was incarcerated for the crimes for which he was convicted. Counsel argued that the present physical condition of Charles Sylvester Stamper is such that he is severely incapacitated, no longer a threat to society, and for all intents and purposes is a paraplegic.

The evidence available to me on October 22, 1992 was neither clear nor conclusive; accordingly, I was unable at that time to reach a resolution as to the actual physical condition of Charles Sylvester Stamper. In order to allow time for the gathering of evidence sufficient to allow me to resolve this issue, I granted a reprieve in the form of a stay of execution and directed the Secretary of Public Safety, with the aid and cooperation of the Virginia Department of Corrections, to assemble all available evidence and prepare a report for me which specifically defined Charles Sylvester Stamper's physical condition. Until I revoke this stay or order other action to be taken, Charles Sylvester Stamper shall continue to remain incarcerated within the Department of Corrections.
