CUSTALOW, Linwood W., M.D.

Pardon Granted: January 12, 1994

Dr. Custalow in his capacity as President of the above named corporation, entered a guilty plea with the understanding that it would have no effect upon him of a personal nature. A review of the files by the Office of the Commonwealth's Attorney in Hampton, Virginia evidenced that Dr. Custalow, in his personal capacity, was not charged with any crime in this case. Dr. Custalow signed the plea agreement in this case as the President of the corporation and not in a personal capacity. Based on this information, the Office of the Commonwealth's Attorney did not believe that there was a conviction of Dr. Custalow in a personal capacity for which a pardon is required.

In determining that there was never an intent to convict Dr. Custalow in his personal capacity in this matter and to the extent that the orders of the Circuit Court of the City of Hampton that were entered on December 20, 1989, and February 16, 1990, can be read to evidence a conviction of Dr. Custalow, that ambiguity was corrected by the Governor granting Dr. Linwood W. Custalow, M.D. an absolute pardon.

On June 26, 1986, Walter T. Snyder, Jr., after having pled not guilty, was convicted of Rape, Cunnilingus, Anal Intercourse, Aggravated Sexual Battery, and Breaking and Entering. On October 14, 1986, he was sentenced to 45 years in prison.

In this case, DNA evidence that had only recently come to light contradicted the strong case that was ably prosecuted by the Commonwealth's Attorney for the City of Alexandria and decided by a jury.

Virginia was one of the first states to recognize the credibility of DNA utilization as a means to identify criminal perpetrators. If it can be used to convict, it must also be used to protect the innocent. The clemency appeal in this case was also extraordinary because the Honorable John E. Kloch, the Commonwealth's Attorney, joined counsel for the petitioner in asking that the Governor grant a pardon.

No fault could be found with the findings that were made by the jury based upon the evidence that was available to it at that time. However, the evidence that had been presented to the Governor concerning the DNA tests that had been conducted only recently, placed a cloud upon the verdict and raised a doubt concerning the ultimate issue of whether Walter T. Snyder, Jr. was guilty of the crime for which he was convicted in 1986. It was very possible that had DNA been perfected as a forensic tool in 1986 and the jury had the advantage of the DNA analysis that had recently been accomplished, it would have reached a different verdict.

Based upon 1) the evidence in the case, 2) the DNA analysis performed by an independent laboratory, 3) the review of the DNA evidence by and the opinion of the Director of the Commonwealth's Division of Forensic Science, 4) the fact that the Petitioner cooperated with the police by submitting to a polygraph examination prior to trial, 5) the arguments of counsel for the Petitioner and the Commonwealth in support of the granting of clemency, and 6) the unanimous recommendation for clemency from the Virginia Parole Board, the Governor agreed that the use of executive clemency was required in this case. As a result, the Governor granted Walter T. Snyder, Jr. an absolute pardon on April 23, 1993.

CONDITIONAL PARDON - FURLOUGH

IVERSON, Allen E.

Allen Iverson was brought to trial in the Circuit Court for the City of Hampton and found guilty of three counts of Maiming by Mob. On September 8, 1993, he received a sentence of five years on each count for a total of fifteen years, ten years of which were suspended.

His counsel sought to have the trial court hear his argument that the particular wording of his order of sentencing prevented him from being classified in to the system of the Virginia Department of Corrections. The failure to be classified prevented him from being considered for good time and continued to extend the time before he could be considered for parole in the same manner as other inmates. The trial judge refused to hear his plea on the grounds that he lacked jurisdiction and the Department of Corrections determined that the order had all the indicia of a final order. After the Department of Corrections classified Allen Iverson, the Parole Board reviewed a request for parole from Allen Iverson and has granted that request effective August 23, 1994.

The Governor found that while there was not sufficient evidence to grant the extraordinary relief inherent in a traditional pardon, there was sufficient doubt to merit that Allen Iverson be granted limited freedom and the opportunity to continue his education. The grant of Conditional Clemency was in the form of a Furlough. It was not intended to usurp the jurisdiction of the judicial system nor was it intended in any manner to comment on the merits of Allen Iverson's case on appeal or interrupt that appellate process which Allen Iverson was undertaking. Inasmuch as the Furlough was in the form of a Conditional Clemency, however, it was subject to Allen Iverson accepting several conditions.

On December 29, 1993, the Furlough became immediately effective and will continue until the effective date of his parole, August 23, 1994, unless one or more of the conditions is violated prior to such date. On August 23, 1994, the Furlough shall expire and Allen Iverson shall be subject to whatever conditions are imposed by the Parole Board and the Department of Corrections.

On September 8, 1993, he received a sentence of five years on each count of Maiming by Mob, with the sentences for two counts suspended for 10 years. He was also sentenced to twelve months in jail on each of the Assault and Battery by Mob charges, both of which were suspended for 10 years. Finally, he was sentenced to six months in jail for the Disorderly Conduct charge, which was also suspended for 10 years.

His counsel sought to have the trial court hear his argument that the particular wording of his order of sentencing prevented him from being classified in to the system of the Virginia Department of Corrections. The trial judge refused to hear his plea on the grounds that he lacked jurisdiction and the Department of Corrections determined that the order had all the indicia of a final order. After the Department of Corrections determined that Michael Richard Simmons should be classified into the State system, he submitted a request for Executive Clemency based upon the fact that there was a reasonable doubt as to his guilt, he had no prior criminal record, and he wished to be allowed to continue his education.

After the Department of Corrections classified Michael Richard Simmons, the Parole Board reviewed the request for parole and the Board granted that request effective August 21, 1994.

While the Governor did not find sufficient evidence to grant the extraordinary relief inherent in a traditional pardon, there was sufficient doubt to merit that Michael Richard Simmons be granted limited freedom and the opportunity to continue his education. This grant of Conditional Clemency was given in the form of a Furlough. It is not intended to usurp the jurisdiction of the judicial system nor was it intended in any manner to comment on the merits of Michael Richard Simmons' case on appeal or interrupt that appellate process which Michael Richard Simmons was presently undertaking. Inasmuch as the Furlough was in the form of a Conditional Clemency, however, it was subject to Michael Richard Simmons accepting several conditions.

On January 13, the Furlough became immediately effective and will continue until the effective date of his parole, August 23, 1994, unless one or more of the conditions be violated prior to such date. On August 21, 1994, the Furlough shall expire and Michael Richard Simmons shall be subject to whatever conditions are imposed by the Parole Board and the Department of Corrections.

He was also sentenced to twelve months in jail on each of the Assault and Battery by Mob charges, both of which were suspended for 10 years. Finally, he was sentenced to six months in jail for the Disorderly Conduct charge, which was also suspended for 10 years.

His counsel sought to have the trial court hear his argument that the particular wording of his order of sentencing prevented him from being classified in to the system of the Virginia Department of Corrections. The trial judge refused to hear his plea on the grounds that he lacked jurisdiction and the Department of Corrections determined that the order had all the indicia of a final order. After the Department of Corrections determined that Samuel Morris Wynn should be classified into the State system, he submitted a request for Executive Clemency based upon the fact that there was a reasonable doubt as to his guilt, he had no prior criminal record, and he wished to be allowed to continue his education.

On April 6, 1994, the Furlough shall expire and Samuel Morris Wynn shall be subject to whatever conditions are imposed by the Parole Board and the Department of Corrections.

She will have to find employment as a special education teacher, within one year of the date of this Conditional Clemency. After obtaining such employment she must serve as a special education teacher for 5 years. If the conditions are breached, the pardon will be null and void. This pardon will not operate to erase the fact or record of the above described offense.

COMMUTATION OF SENTENCE

Earl Washington, Jr., was brought to trial in the Circuit Court of the County of Culpeper for the murder of Rebecca Lynn Williams with premeditation subsequent to the commission of a rape. He was tried by a jury of his peers and found guilty as charged and it fixed his punishment at death. On March 20, 1984, the judge entered a final order imposing the death sentence. Since that time, the defendant's case has gone through numerous appeals both within the courts of the Commonwealh and the United States. No court before which an appeal has been presented has granted the complete relief sought.

A review of the record of the trial and of the appeals that were taken demonstrate that Earl Washington, Jr. received a fair trial and his appeals were well presented and considered. Recently, newly discovered evidence has become available as the result of the initiatives of the Attorney General's Office. It is clear from precedent in past cases and based upon discussions with the Attorney General's Office and counsel for Earl Washington, Jr. that there are no provisions under Virginia law whereby such newly discovered evidence can now be considered by the courts.

The newly discovered evidence was the result of DNA testing of biological samples that had been taken from the body f the victim in the case. The results were discussed with the Director of the Virginia Division of Forensic Science. It was confirmed that DNA characteristics were found which matched the victim, her husband, and Earl Washington, Jr. In addition, characteristics were found which matched none of those people. Even with the new evidence, however, questions continued to remain concerning the independent validity and strength of other evidence. A review of the trial evidence reveals that Earl Washington, Jr. had knowledge of evidence relating to the crime which it can be argued only the perpetrator would have known.

Taking into consideration all of the foregoing, the Governor was of the opinion that the newly discovered evidence interjected an important element into the case which neither the jury that tried the case nor the courts which have reviewed it since the trial have had the opportunity to consider. Had that opportunity arose, the Governor was of the opinion that their opinions as to the appropriate conclusion may have been different.

On January 17, 1994, the Governor commuted the sentence of death for the capital murder conviction to life imprisonment with the right of parole. Earl Washington, Jr.'s parole eligibility shall be determined by the appropriate authorities. The commutation is conditioned upon his maintaining good conduct and cooperating with Department of Corrections officials. Should he commit a felony during his imprisonment, the commutation will be null and void and he will serve life imprisonment without parole. Nothing in the commutation precludes Mr. Washington from using the new evidence in a retrial should the General Assembly adopt such a provision.
