ABSOLUTE PARDON

HONAKER, Edward William

On February 7, 1985 Mr. Honaker, having pled not guilty to all of the charges, nevertheless was found guilty by a jury of his peers of all of the crimes charged. On April 10, 1985 Judge Robert C. Goad, imposed the sentence recommended by the jury which totaled three life terms plus 34 years.

Through his counsel, Mr. Honaker petitioned Governor Allen on June 24, 1994 for a grant of Executive Clemency. The principal ground of the petition was that recently completed DNA tests established that another person with DNA characteristics inconsistent with Mr. Honaker had committed the crimes for which Mr. Honaker was convicted.

On July 22, 1994, the Honorable Phillip D. Payne, IV, Commonwealth's Attorney for Nelson County whose office prosecuted Mr. Honaker, sent Governor Allen a letter in which he requested that Mr. Honaker's petition for Executive Clemency be granted. Mr. Payne based his recommendation upon independant DNA tests conducted at his request by the Commonwea'th of Virginia's Division of Forensic Science, whose tests had produced results consistent with those obtained by the independent laboratory.

The Governor convened a group of law enforcement experts to provide technical assistance in a thorough review of the contentions made in the clemency petition, the evidence adduced at the trial, and the scientific evidence that had become available after the Honaker trial as a result of technological advances in the field of DNA testing.

The results of this review and the DNA testing established that Mr. Honaker could not have been the source of the genetic material taken from the victim following these crimes.

The Division of Forensic Science and the independent laboratory independently reached the same findings and conclusions.

ABSOLUTE PARDON

Relying on the recommendations of reputable citizens who are familiar with this man's conduct since his conviction, the fact that he has made restitution in the amount of \$800, that the Removal of Political Disabilities and a simple pardon was granted by Governor Dalton in June of 1978, that an absolute pardon was granted to this man's co-defendant by Governor Godwin, and in the interest of consistency and fundamental justice, there being no objection from the sentencing judge, The Honorable Frank A.S. Wright, an absolute pardon was granted by Governor Allen.
