Comprehensive Services for At-Risk Youth and Families Medicaid Utilization for Comprehensive Services Act Services

The 2004 Appropriations Act, Chapter 4, contains language in Item 299, J requiring the Office of Comprehensive Services to report on the progress in “increasing Medicaid utilization for CSA services. The report shall also recommend additional strategies, as necessary, for increasing Medicaid utilization”

Background

In 1997, the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) published its “Review of the Comprehensive Services Act”. This report made a number of recommendations for the improvement of the CSA. One recommendation urged the use of Medicaid funding to serve children whose placements were in facilities and programs for which Medicaid payment could be made. In this way, federal matching funds could be obtained for services currently funded from state and local funds. As a result of the JLARC report, the 1998 Appropriations Act directed the Department of Medical Assistance Services to add two services to the State Plan for Medical Assistance: Treatment Foster Care and Residential Treatment. Medicaid coverage of these two services became effective January 2000.

Since inception in January 2000, a total of \$232.4 million in residential treatment and treatment foster care services have been paid. (\$173.8 million in residential and \$58.6 million in treatment foster care). These amounts represent Medicaid payments through August 2004. Chart 1 below summarizes total Medicaid payments for each fiscal year:

Locality Utilization

Medicaid providers are allowed up to one year in which to bill Medicaid for services. Occasionally, the appeal process, should a dispute regarding eligibility arise, may extend this timeframe. As such, in order to better measure Medicaid utilization, Medicaid expenditures have been summarized based on the actual year the service was performed

versus the fiscal year the payment was made. Chart 2 below summarizes total Medicaid payments, this time scheduled by program year (ie the year the specific Medicaid service was actually provided to the child):

Attached to this report is a graphic illustration of treatment foster care and residential service total expenditures by year from FY00 through the Fy04 program year.

To obtain a more accurate perspective of Medicaid usage, locality specific Medicaid expenditures by program year reports have been created. Schedule 1 reports total treatment foster care and residential expenditures by program year. Actual Medicaid expenditures paid by DMAS are summarized beginning with the program year 2000 (six months from January 2000) and reports through August 2005. Also attached are Schedule 2, summarizing locality residential treatment services and Schedule 3, summarizing locality specific treatment foster care services by program year.


Medicaid Strategies to Increase Medicaid Utilization

The Department of Medicaid Assistance Services (DMAS) has collaboratively worked closely with the Office of Comprehensives since the inception of treatment foster care and residential services to ensure the fullest possible utilization of Medicaid applicable services for CSA children. The strategies used include:

- DMAS was invited and now actively participates in the Office of Comprehensive Services Technical Assistance and Training Group (TAG). The TAG group represents a collaborative group of state and local CSA stakeholders charged with identifying and resolving specific CSA training needs.
- In conjunction with the DMAS memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Office of Comprehensive Services, DMAS has agreed to provide training for local CSA teams and providers on proper utilization of Medicaid for treatment foster care and residential services. This training includes, but is not limited to, claims processing, utilization review and prior authorization of all services related to Medicaid coverage. CSA coordinators and providers are invited to attend these sessions.

- DMAS staff is available for consultation and assistance in answering questions regarding provider enrollment, service provision and billing inquiries.
- DMAS is an active participant with CSA groups charged to identify provider issues and resolution.
- DMAS is a member of the State and Local Advisory Team (SLAT). The SLAT, established by Section 2.2-52.1 Code of Virginia, is charged with managing cooperative efforts at the state level and providing support to community efforts.
- In the fall of 2004, DMAS has notified current Medicaid, FAMIS Plus and FAMIS enrollees under the age of 21 containing information about EPSDT, a prevention and treatment program available to children. The goal of EPSDT is to assure that health problems are diagnosed and treated as early as possible.
- The 2004 Appropriations Act, Chapter 4, contains language requiring the Department of Medicaid Assistance Services to amend the State Plan for Medicaid Assistance to include reimbursement for required tuition payments for children receiving Medicaid-eligible residential services, provided such educational services are part of the (child's) treatment plan by July 1, 2005. Currently, DMAS is developing the cost impact of this initiative.
- Effective July 1, 2004, two new Medicaid community based residential treatment services were initiated. As this service just began, meaningful results are not available at this time (through the August 2004 Medicaid billing report, a total of \$20k has been reimbursed). This service is budgeted at \$10.9 million in FY05.
- DMAS frequently attends and makes presentations to CSA coordinator groups.
- In November 2004, DMAS will announce changes to the Community Mental health Rehabilitative Services Manual that will make easier access to current services.
