RE: Minority-Owned Business Participation in State Procurement

Dear Governor Warner and Members of the General Assembly:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 2.2-1405 of the Code of Virginia, the Department of Minority Business Enterprise (DMBE) respectfully submits the attached report detailing its analysis of minorityowned business participation in the procurement of goods and services in the Commonwealth. A copy of this report has been forwarded to both the Clerks of the House of Delegates and Senate of Virginia.

The Department is pleased to announce that agencies and institutions of the Commonwealth have substantially met the reporting requirements established by Section 2.2-1405. Annual totals for each agency and institution are included in this report.

The reported overall dollar amount for the procurement of goods and services totaled \$3,560,598,406.20 for the 2004 Fiscal Year. Of this amount, \$83,866,020.03 or 2.36% was reported as expended with minority-owned firms. A verification of this data through the Commonwealth Accounting Reporting System (CARS) shows that of the nearly \$3.5 billion paid for state purchases, payments of only \$39,548,931.27 or 1.11% (just over one percent) were made to certified minority-owned businesses. DMBE's analysis is presented as follows:

Chart A reflects the reported levels of procurement expenditure by each Executive Branch Secretariat, Judicial Branch and Legislative Branch of government;

Chart B provides the breakdown of the levels of procurement expenditures in each Secretariat and by each agency within the Secretariat; and

Chart C reflects actual recorded payments (CARS, etc.) to certified minority firms, by product/service codes.


