**Report of the Chief Information Officer of the Commonwealth
Public-Private Partnership Contracts
(As per *Code of Virginia*, §2.2-2007.B)**

As per the requirements of the above-referenced Code section, I hereby report that for the reporting period ending November 1, 2004, there were no consummated public-private partnership contracts to finance or implement information technology programs and projects.

Under the ~~Public-Private Educational Facilities and Infrastructure Act~~ provisions of the Commonwealth Model Procedures for PPEA (Public-Private Educational Facilities and Infrastructure Act), the Virginia Information Technologies Agency is currently considering unsolicited proposals from three vendors—Cap Gemini/American Management Systems (CGI-AMS), IBM, and Northrop Grumman. These proposals are just entering the Detailed Stage of proposal development and review, which may or may not result in negotiations leading to one or more Comprehensive Agreements (i.e., contracts) sometime in calendar 2005.
