Dear Chairmen:

Section 15.2-5822 B of the *Code of Virginia* requires me to submit a report to the Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, Chairman of the House Finance Committee, and the Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee, on the amount of the entitlement to sales tax revenues derived from a major league baseball stadium pursuant to § 15.2-5814.

In connection with the issuance of bonds by the Virginia Baseball Stadium Authority to finance a major league baseball stadium, the *Code* states "the Authority shall be entitled to all sales tax revenues that are generated by transactions taking place upon the premises of the major league baseball stadium." Presently, there has been no construction or acquisition of a stadium; thus, there are no revenues to report.
