Dear Governor Kaine and Messrs. Chairmen:

It is my pleasure to submit this report pursuant to §22.1-167.3 (C) of the <u>Code of Virginia</u> as enacted in 2001 (enclosed), concerning certain notes of the Virginia Public School Authority (VPSA) secured by a sum sufficient appropriation as provided in Item 135(C)(14) of the 2007 Appropriation Act.

The School Educational Technology Notes Resolutions adopted on March 19, 2001, March 18, 2002, March 19, 2003, March 17, 2004, March 16, 2005, March 17, 2006 and March 23, 2007 by the VPSA Board of Commissioners, utilized the additional security provided by the sum sufficient appropriation to achieve higher credit ratings for the VPSA's technology notes issues from the three major credit rating agencies.

During the fiscal year ended June 30, 2007, the VPSA issued an additional series of school educational technology notes under the School Educational Technology Notes Resolution adopted on March 23, 2007. Accordingly, as of June 30, 2007, the total amount of the Authority's outstanding bonds as described in §22.1-167.3 (C) of the <u>Code of Virginia</u> was \$172,390,000.
