Dear Chairmen:

Virginia Code § 17.1-507 provides that the Judicial Council shall make a study and report to the Courts of Justice Committees of the House of Delegates and Senate on the number of new circuit court judgeships needed and the circuits for which they should be authorized. The Judicial Council has found the need for six new circuit court judgeships (one each in the Tenth, Fourteenth, Fifteenth, Twenty-sixth, Twenty-seventh and Thirtieth Judicial Circuits).

Despite the documented need for these new judgeships, the Chief Justice is aware of the significant economic difficulties facing the Commonwealth, For this reason, the Chief Justice does not intend to seek authorization of these new judgeships during the 2009 Session of the General Assembly,
