Annual Report on State Jobs Eliminated Due to Privatization

Section 2.2-203.2:1, Code of Virginia, requires the Secretary of Administration to report each year "to the Governor and the General Assembly on the number of state jobs eliminated in the immediately preceding fiscal year due to the privatization of commercial activities to a commercial source. As used in this section, 'commercial activities' and 'commercial source' shall mean the same as those terms are defined in § 2.2-2620, Code of Virginia."

Agencies reported to the Department of Human Resource Management that eleven positions were privatized during fiscal year 2008. The Virginia State Lottery privatized nine (9) positions (2 in retailer support, 5 in computer operations, and 2 in systems). The Virginia Employment Commission privatized a single clerical position. Northern Virginia Training Center also privatized a single clerical position.
