### Dear Chairmen:

Virginia Code § 16.1-69.10 provides that the Committee on District Courts shall make a study and report to the General Assembly on the number of district court judges needed and the districts for which they should be authorized. The Committee on District Courts has found the need for four new general district judgeships (one each in the Second, Eleventh, Fifteenth and Twenty-sixth Judicial Districts), and six new juvenile and domestic relations district court judgeships (one each in the First, Eleventh, Fifteenth, Sixteenth, Twenty-eighth and Twentyninth Judicial Districts),

Despite the documented need for these new judgeships, the Chief Justice is aware of the significant economic difficulties facing the Commonwealth, For this reason, the Chief Justice does not intend to seek authorization of these new judgeships during the 2009 Session of the General Assembly.
