Subject:	Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission Report on Waste Reduction Efforts in Virginia (2008) Status Report

I am pleased to provide you with a summary of the Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ's) completion of one of the recommendations contained in the Joint legislative Audit and Review Commission's (JLARC) "Report on Waste Reduction Efforts in Virginia" (2008). In its report, JLARC recommended that DEQ "determine the funding needs of local recycling and litter prevention efforts and report the amounts needed to fully fund each to the General Assembly by the 2010 Session. The General Assembly may wish to consider creating a separate fund from which to provide grant funding for local recycling efforts."

In response to this recommendation, DEQ developed a survey instrument to obtain information about the funding needs of the local programs. Several local government representatives and members of the Virginia Recycling Association assisted with the development of the survey. A copy of the survey instrument is attached.

The survey was distributed electronically to all county and city administrators/managers in July 2009. Sixty-nine percent (93 out of 134) localities submitted a completed survey to DEQ. The results of the returned surveys have been compiled and summarized as follows:

- an additional \$12.8 million would be needed to fully fund local recycling and litter prevention programs state-wide.
- the identified uses for this additional funding included four primary categories: personnel and administrative costs; additional equipment; program expansions, and cleanup and outreach programs. In terms of priority, these four categories received approximately equal weight in the survey responses.

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L. Preston Bryant, Jr. Secretary of Natural Resources Localities reported the following program budget information in the completed surveys:
