Annual Report on State Jobs Eliminated Due to Privatization

Section 2.2-203.2:1, Code of Virginia, requires the Secretary of Administration to report on or before November 30 of each year "to the Governor and the General Assembly on the number of state jobs eliminated in the immediately preceding fiscal year due to the privatization of commercial activities to a commercial source. As used in this section, 'commercial activities' and 'commercial source' shall mean the same as those terms are defined in § 2.2-2620."

Agencies reported to the Department of Human Resource Management that 19 positions were privatized during fiscal year 2009. Virginia Western Community College privatized three (3) positions, all in retail operations (2 specialists and 1 manager). The Virginia Port Authority privatized 16 positions, all in marketing, with Virginia International Terminals (VPA's private operating company) assuming 13 of them.
