Dear Governor McDonnell and Chairmen Colgan and Putney:

Virginia Code § 19.2-163 requires the Executive Secretary to report to the Governor, members of the House Appropriations Committee and members of the Senate Finance Committee, on a quarterly basis, "the number and category of offenses charged involving adult and juvenile offenders in cases in which court-appointed counsel is assigned" and "the amounts paid by waiver above the initial cap to court-appointed counsel."

During fiscal year 2011, 10,229 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 4,241,913, and 9,708 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 3,800,627 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
