SUBJECT:

Setoff Debt Collection Program Costs

Pursuant to §58.1-531 of the *Code of Virginia*, I am reporting the administrative cost of the Setoff Debt Collection Program for fiscal year 2011. The Setoff Debt Collection Program allows state and local government agencies to offset certain debts against individual tax refunds and lottery prize winnings.

During fiscal year 2011, 309,642 individual claims totaling \$51,988,998 were paid at an estimated cost of \$280,894. A detailed report of costs incurred to support the Setoff Debt Collection Program is attached. The average cost per claim was \$0.91. The average claim was \$167.90.

The Setoff Debt Collection program continues to be a cost effective and efficient means of collecting delinquent state and local revenues. Please contact me if additional information is required or desired.
