## Annual Report on State Jobs Eliminated Due to Privatization

Section 2.2-203.2:1, Code of Virginia, requires the Secretary of Administration to report "to the Governor and the General Assembly on the number of state jobs eliminated in the immediately preceding fiscal year due to the privatization of commercial activities to a commercial source. As used in this section, 'commercial activities' and 'commercial source' shall mean the same as those terms are defined in § 2.2-2620."

Agencies reported to the Department of Human Resource Management that 36 positions were privatized during fiscal year 2010.

- The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services and the facilities it operates
  privatized a total of 11 positions consisting of four (4) trades technicians (plumbers, electricians,
  painters), a launderer, a mail operator, three (3) pharmacy technicians, and two (2)
  administrative employees.
- · The Department of Correctional Education privatized an accounting position.
- · Virginia Western Community College privatized a public relations position.
- The Department of Transportation privatized 23 positions engaged in cashiering/toll collecting, bookkeeping, and their administrative support and supervision.
