Dear Chairmen:

Virginia Code § 17.1-507 provides that the Judicial Council shall make a study and report to the Courts of Justice Committees of the House of Delegates and Senate on the number of new circuit court judgeships needed and the circuits for which they should be authorized. The Judicial Council last studied the need for new circuit court judgeships in 2008. At that time, the Council found the need for six new circuit court judgeships. However, due to the economic difficulties faced by the Commonwealth, the Chief Justice did not seek authorization for these new judgeships during the 2009 Session of the General Assembly.

Since that time, the Supreme Court has not intended to seek authorization for any new judgeships, and although a study of the judicial boundaries was undertaken this summer at the request of the Senate Courts of Justice Committee, the Judicial Council has not conducted a study regarding the need for new circuit court judgeships.
