RE: Report on Item 297 PPPP.3 of the 2011 Appropriations Act related to  
Changes for Intensive In-Home and Residential Services

Item 297 PPPP of the 2011 Appropriations Act directed the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) to report to the Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees the specific programmatic changes that will be made for intensive in-home and residential services including an estimate of the fiscal impact of the proposed changes no less than 30 days prior to implementing the changes.
