Dear Messrs. Chairmen:

I am writing to report on the grants that have been awarded during the second quarter of the 2013 calendar year as required by § 2.2-5103(D) of the Code of Virginia.

For the second quarter, ending June 30, 2013, six Virginia Investment Partnership grants were awarded. In the Major Eligible Employer category (over \$100 million in capital investment and at least 1,000 new employees or corporate headquarters and other basic employers that make a capital investment of at least \$100 million and create at least 400 jobs paying at least twice the prevailing average wage for the area), there were no grants awarded.

Virginia Investment Partnership:

1. **WhiteWave Foods Company**, located in Rockingham County, manufactures, markets, distributes, and sells foods and beverages. Awarded an \$800,000 grant, the company will be making a \$69.8 million investment and creating 36 new jobs by June 30, 2015.
2. **Sabra Dipping Company**, located in Chesterfield County, manufactures kosher vegetarian prepared foods. Awarded a \$500,000 grant, the company will be making an \$86 million investment and creating 140 new jobs by May 31, 2016.
3. **HP Hood**, located in Frederick County, manufactures dairy products. Awarded a \$1 million grant, the company will be making an \$84.6 million investment and creating 75 new jobs by May 31, 2016.
4. **Iluka Resources**, located in Dinwiddie County, mines ore. Awarded a \$300,000 grant, the company will be making a \$67 million investment and creating 86 new jobs by June 30, 2016.
5. **Canon Virginia (Project H)**, located in the City of Newport News, is a contract manufacturing and parts fabrication service that assembles new and remanufactured office equipment. Awarded a \$5 million grant (reduced from a \$20 million MEE), the company made a \$370 million investment and created 402 new jobs by the end of 2012.
6. **Canon Virginia (Toner)**, located in the City of Newport News, is a contract manufacturing and parts fabrication service that assembles new and remanufactured office equipment. This expansion will bring the toner production to Virginia from China. Awarded a \$3 million grant, the company will make a \$27 million investment and save 12 existing jobs by May 31, 2015.


