In accordance with Chapter 1024, enactment clause 2, of the 2004 Acts of Assembly, please find below information on the number of petitions for writs of actual innocence filed pursuant to Chapter 19.3 of Title 19.2, and the dispositions thereof, for calendar year 2013.

- Four petitions were pending on January 1, 2013.
- Twenty-seven petitions were filed in 2013.
- Twenty-six petitions were disposed of in 2013. The dispositions of those cases were as follows:
 - Twenty-three petitions were summarily dismissed.
 - Two petitions were dismissed following consideration of the Attorney General's response to the petition and petitioner's reply thereto, if any.
 - One writ was issued, and petitioner's convictions vacated.
- Five petitions were pending as of December 31, 2013.
