During 1st quarter of fiscal year 2016, 1,606 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 729,536, and 1,435 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 636,763 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
