Dear Senators Hanger and Norment and Delegate Jones:

Item 4-9.04 d., Chapter 780, 2016 Acts of Assembly, requires the Department of Planning and Budget (DPB) to annually report on the allocation recommendations for the Commonwealth of Virginia's maintenance reserve funding to account for higher maintenance needs resulting from poor facility conditions, aging of facilities, and differences in facility use.

Because maintenance reserve funding is typically provided in the biennial budget and agencies need time to plan their maintenance projects, DPB is not recommending changes to the amounts allocated to agencies for maintenance reserve during the middle of the biennium. The only proposal in the Governor's introduced budget related to maintenance reserve adds \$953,057 in bond funding to the Department of Military Affairs to allow it to adequately address the lack of fire detection equipment in some of its armories (readiness centers).

The proposed budget for the 2018-20 biennium will include recommendations for new appropriations and allocations for maintenance reserve funding.
