I am writing in response to your letter of March 9, regarding the disposition of Delegate James Leftwich's House Bill 1640. The bill was passed by indefinitely in the Senate Transportation Committee, with a letter asking the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to address the issue raised by his legislation. The legislation sought to place information on the DMV website listing the steps necessary to title and register a trailer in Virginia that had previously been housed in a state that does not title or register trailers.

I am pleased to report that this information was posted to the DMV website on February 6 of this year. The process for titling trailers identified by HB 1640 can be found at the following link: <a href="https://www.dmv.virginia.gov/vehicles/#titling.html">https://www.dmv.virginia.gov/vehicles/#titling.html</a>. Department staff was pleased to be able to address this issue through administrative actions prior to the conclusion of the General Assembly session.
