During the first quarter of fiscal year 2018, 2,716 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 1,580,547 and 2,599 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 1,455,520 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
