Annual Report on State Jobs Eliminated Due to Privatization

Section 2.2-203.2:1, Code of Virginia, requires the Secretary of Administration to report “to the Governor and the General Assembly on the number of state jobs eliminated in the immediately preceding fiscal year due to the privatization of commercial activities to a commercial source. As used in this section, ‘*commercial activities*’ and ‘*commercial source*’ shall mean the same as those terms are defined in § 2.2-2620.”

Agencies reported to the Department of Human Resource Management that five positions were privatized during fiscal year 2017.

- The Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) transitioned accounts receivable work to Myers and Stauffer LC, Certified Public Accountants.
 - Five Financial Services Specialist I positions were eliminated. Four of the actions were Enhanced Retirements and one was Layoff: Severance Only.
