Virginia Code § 19.2-163 requires the Executive Secretary to report to the Governor, members of the House Appropriations Committee and members of the Senate Finance Committee, on a quarterly basis, "the number and category of offenses charged involving adult and juvenile offenders in cases in which courtappointed counsel is assigned" and "the amounts paid by waiver above the initial cap to court-appointed counsel."

The following table details the vouchers submitted for compensation by courtappointed counsel during the first three quarters of fiscal year 2018 and reflects the number and category of offenses charged involving adult and juvenile offenders:

During the first three quarters of fiscal year 2018, 7,579 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 4,625,957, and 7,192 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 4,243,566 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
