Dear Messrs. Chairmen:

I am writing to report on the Virginia Investment Performance (VIP) and Major Eligible Employer (MEE) grants that were awarded during the first quarter of the 2019 calendar year as required by § 2.2-5103(D) of the Code of Virginia.

In the first quarter, ending March 31, 2019, four VIP grants were awarded. No MEE grants were awarded in the first quarter of 2019.

### Virginia Investment Performance:

- 1. Klockner Pentaplast of America, located in Louisa County, is a manufacturer of coating and laminating barrier films. Awarded a \$300,000 grant, the company will be making a \$25 million investment and creating 34 new jobs by December 31, 2021. This project has been announced.
- M.C. Dean, located in Albemarle County, is a manufacturer and distributor of electrical
  engineering and systems integration. Awarded a \$250,000 grant, the company will be
  making a \$25.1 million investment and creating 100 new jobs by December 31, 2021.

3. The Clorox Company, located in the City of Danville, is a manufacturer of cat litter. Awarded a \$1,000,000 grant, the company will be making a \$90 million investment and creating 102 new jobs by June 30, 2022. This project has been announced.

4. The Hershey Company, located in Augusta County, is a confectionary manufacturer. Awarded a \$400,000 grant, the company will be making a \$104.4 million investment and creating 65 new jobs by June 30, 2022. This project has been announced.

### Major Eligible Employer:

No MEE grants were awarded.

For the first quarter of the 2019 calendar year, 11 disbursements from the VIP were made to Mondelez, Volvo, Celanese Acetate, WestRock/Covington, Chicopee, Orbital Sciences, PPD, WestRock/Hopewell, Greif, Ashland, and Unilever for projects previously reported. No MEE grant disbursements from the Fund were made.
