Executive Summary

At the direction of Virginia Code §23.1-102.1, this Annual Report on Executive Officers Salaries provides the salary by position of any executive officer of Christopher Newport that exceeded for the previous fiscal year the salary limit for the president of Christopher Newport. The Rector of the Board of Visitors submitted the report directly to the chairmen of the House Committees on Appropriations and Education and the Senate Committees on Finance and Education and Health.

In FY2019, salaries for eight executive officers of Christopher Newport exceeded the appropriated salary of \$142,606 for the president. The positions and salaries are listed below. The positions report directly to the president and have decision-making authority.
