
I am pleased to submit the enclosed report that summarizes income data for the Virginia Preschool Initiative program for 2019-2020.

Item 136.C.14.d.2 directs the Department of Education to compile from each school division the aggregated information as to the number of enrolled students whose families are (i) at or below 130 percent of poverty, (ii) above 130 percent but at or below 200 percent of poverty, (iii) above 200 percent of poverty but at or below 350 percent of poverty, and (iv) above 350 percent of poverty. The Department is required to report this information annually, after the application and fall participation reports are submitted to the Department from the school divisions, to the Chairmen of House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees.
