Dear Governor Northam, Delegate Bell, and Senator Newman:

Pursuant to Va. Code § 23.1-401.1, George Mason University ("Mason") submits this report regarding its compliance with that statute. Enclosed please find a copy of Mason's policies related to constitutionally protected speech. Mason has also created a web page, www2.gmu.edu/1stAmendment, where these policies can be found along with other materials developed by Mason related to constitutionally protected speech. Mason also certifies that it complies with Section C of the statute by sending an email to all Mason faculty and staff annually informing them of the above referenced web page. Mason informed all incoming students of this web page and presented materials related to constitutionally protected speech during orientation.

Finally, enclosed please find one complaint filed in a court of law since December 1, 2018 to initiate a lawsuit against Mason and employees of Mason in their official capacity for an alleged violation of the First Amendment to the United States Constitution.
