III. Actions taken in compliance with § 23.1-1303 Boards of Visitors; Bylaws.

The Radford University Board of Visitors Bylaws were updated in July 2019 to include the immediate past Rector as an ex-officio member of the Executive Committee.

The Radford University Board of Visitors Bylaws were updated December 2019 to add that: "In accordance with Code of Virginia, § 23.1-307(D) and (E), Radford University will provide public notice at least 30 days prior to considering an increase undergraduate tuition or mandatory fees. The Radford University Board of Visitors will announce a public comment forum prior to the vote. The procedures for the Public Comment Session are approved by the Board of Visitors and maintained on the Board of Visitors website."

IV. Actions taken in compliance with § 23.1-1303 Boards of Visitors; Annual meeting with the president of the institution.

Pursuant to § 23.1-1303 and in accordance with the Bylaws of the Board of Visitors of Radford University, the Board does meet annually with the President concerning his/her review.

President Brian O. Hemphill previewed initiatives for the 2019-2020 academic year with Board of Visitors members at the July 14-16, 2019 Board Retreat. President Hemphill also provided data and benchmarks regarding performance for the 2018-2019 academic year at the May 10, 2019 Executive Committee and Board meetings. Strategies and outcomes were discussed. At the December 6, 2019 meeting, the Board of Visitors received an interim update for President Brian O. Hemphill's Performance Plan and related progress for the 2019-2020 academic year.
