SUBJECT: Estimate of impact of enhanced FMAP on Medical Assistance Programs

This report is submitted in compliance with Item 307 II of Chapter 1283 of the 2020 Acts of Assembly.

"Within 10 days of the enactment of this Act, the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) shall generate an estimate of the annual impact of enhanced federal Medical Assistance Percentages (FMAP), associated with federal H.R. 6021, the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA), on all medical assistance programs as appropriated in this Act. The agency shall report these estimates by fiscal year, fiscal quarter, service area and fund detail, to the Department of Planning and Budget (DPB) and the Chairs of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance and Appropriation Committees within the required timeframe. DPB is authorized to unallot an amount of state funds equal to the general fund savings identified in the DMAS report."

The attached report calculates the impact of the enhanced Federal Medical Assistance Percentages (FMAP) of 6.2% provided by Sec. 6008 (a) of federal Public Law (P.L.) 116-127, the Families First Coronavirus Response Act. The enhanced FMAP is contingent on Virginia meeting "maintenance of effort requirements" described in Sec. 6008 (b) of P.L. 116-127. This report calculates the impact of the enhanced FMAP on fiscal year 2020 by recalculating the allocation between General Funds, Provider Rate Assessment, and Federal Funds for Items

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302, 303, and 305 for the 2019 Appropriation Act. This recalculation is based on the increased 6.2% for Federal funds minus the estimated costs to meet the maintenance of effort requirements in Sec. 6008 (b).

This report also provides a preliminary estimate of the impact of the increased FMAP on items 312, 313, and 315 in House Bill (HB) 30 covering fiscal years 2021 and 2022. The estimate assumes the items unallotted in Item 317.10 are not included. This report makes no assumption about the end of the state of emergency and carries the enhanced FMAP through the entire biennium. DMAS will provide an updated analysis of fiscal years 2021 and 2022, including an estimate of the cost to meet the Sec. 6008 (b) maintenance of effort requirements, as part of the report required by Item 317 FF in HB 30, after approval by the Governor.
