## State Funding of Abortions in Cases of Fetal Anomalies

## **Background**

## Appropriation Act - Item 289 I. (Regular Session, 2019)

Monthly report on the number of procedures approved for payment pursuant to § 32.1-92.2, Code of Virginia, including a description of the nature of the fetal abnormality, to the extent permitted by law, as required for eligibility under § 32.1-92.2, Code of Virginia. (June 2019)

Although the above language was included in the Appropriations Act, signed on May 2, 2019, the General Assembly simultaneously prohibited the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) to use funds for abortions authorized by state statute. Due to this prohibition, VDH did not consider any funding applications for cases of fetal anomalies between May 2, 2019 and April 24, 2020. The bill to amend and reenact § 58.1-638 of the Code of Virginia and to repeal the fifth enactment of Chapter 17 and the fifth enactment of Chapter 18 of the Acts of Assembly of 2019, signed on April 24, 2020, lifted the prohibition. Information for the remaining months of SFY20 are listed in Table 1.
