Re: Annual report on the Virginia Values Veterans (V3) Employment Grant

Dear Secretary Hopkins, Delegate Torian, and Senator Howell:

The Virginia Values Veterans (V3) Program creates employment opportunities for Virginia veterans by educating and training employers to implement nationally recognized best practices in recruiting, hiring, and retaining veterans. Over 2,000 private and public sector employers participate in the V3 Program, and nearly 65,000 veterans have been hired by V3 partners to date.

The V3 Employment Grant Program was created to incentive small to medium-sized V3 partners to hire and retain veterans. \$100,000 per fiscal year is set aside in the Appropriations Act to support the grant program. Chapter 1289, 2020 Acts of Assembly, Item 464 A.4, directs the Department of Veterans Services to report any shortage of funding resulting from requests in excess of the available appropriation.

The table below details the number of applications received, the number of grants awarded, and the total amount of grant funds disbursed in Fiscal Years 2018, 2019, and 2020. To date, there have been no shortfalls in funding resulting from requests in excess of the available appropriation.
