Dear Governor and Committee Chairs:

In accordance with Chapters 1217 and 1277 of the 2020 Acts of Assembly, the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority is pleased to provide this report on games of skill activity within the Commonwealth for the month of August 2020.

Enactment three (3) of Chapters 1217 and 1277 of the 2020 Acts of Assembly instructs the Authority to provide aggregate information submitted by Skill Game distributors on a monthly basis for your review and information.

Appended to this report is a matrix indicating (i) the total number of skill games provided for play in Virginia by distributor, (ii) the address of each location where skill games are provided for play by the distributor, (iii) the total number of skill games provided for play by the distributor at each respective location, (iv) the total amount wagered during the previous month on each skill game provided for play in Virginia by the distributor at each respective location where the skill game was provided, and (v) the total amount of prizes or winnings awarded during the previous month on each skill game provided for play in Virginia by the distributor at each respective location where the skill game was provided.



For the month of August 2020, there were approximately 10,134 reported skill games in play in Virginia. Those skill game distributors reported that there were \$173,733,020.01 wagered on skill games and \$133,888,079.08 in prize winnings.

The below table contains compiled data reported to the Authority from skill game distributors' required monthly reports received by the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority Bureau of Law Enforcement. The table delineates the data in accordance with designated regions of the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Authority Bureau of Law Enforcement.



*Distributor 019 registered for 139, but it was noted that 2 labels were destroyed and only 137 were handed out.
 Distributor 021 over registered and had 1 machine that was not ready for play in time of registration.
 Distributor 033 registered for 15, but the tracking sheet noted 13 while a location was being verified. Once verified, 2 additional labels were handed out.
 Distributor 042 registered for 33, but it was noted on the tracking sheet that 2 labels were destroyed.
 Distributor 088 registered for 6, but we removed 3 due to Danville not allowing games.
 Distributor 091 registered for 20 at a location that is not a truck stop, so received 12 less labels.
 It was later determined that 12 labels would be granted for use at other locations because the original location was an ABC retail licensee.*

August total count after factoring in the above = 10,303 (Target from initial registration 10,309) Additional analysis will continue of the monthly reports.

We hope this information is helpful to you in understanding the volume of skill game distributors in the Commonwealth and the amount of dollars wagered on skill games.
