Authority: Appropriation Act - Item 78 E.3. (Regular Session, 2020)

The department in consultation with relevant state agencies, shall submit a report identifying options for warehousing supplies needed to support state shelters to include associated storage and supply management resource costs to store and maintain needed supplies. The department shall report its findings to the Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees, the Secretary of Administration, the Secretary of Health and Human Resources, the Secretary of Education, and the Secretary of Public Safety and Homeland Security, and the Secretary of Finance.

The DSS plan and report on the Model State Shelter Plan has been delayed to the demand on Virginia Department of Social Services staff resources posed by the response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Office of the Governor has granted an extension date until October 15, 2021 for the delivery of the report mandated by Item 358.B.1. of the 2020 Appropriation Act.
