The report shall include statements describing the fiscal impact of such amendments or modifications and shall be submitted within 30 days following the signing of any amended agreement."

In addition to this formal report, VITA continues to report to policymakers in detail on the IT infrastructure services contracts and platform through both executive reporting and ongoing oversight by Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) staff.

Number 12	Date 5/4/2021	This amendment, which is related to a settlement agreement, addressed baselines, rate structures, and other invoicing-related matters.	This amendment and settlement result in ~\$1.17M in budget savings between FY21-23. It includes a \$1.5M one-time payment to ATOS in FY21 and savings of ~\$2.67M
			spread over FY21-23 due to the result of changes in the rate structure for several services. It also resolves several other outstanding issues, which could have resulted in claims against VITA with a cost impact.
