During fiscal year 2021, 7,333 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 4,031,111, and 6,943 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 3,682,017 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
