During the first two quarters of fiscal year 2021, 3,695 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 2,002,818, and 3,471 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 1,827,823 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
