BACKGROUND / INTRODUCTION

VITA, on behalf of the Secretary of Administration, Grindly Johnson, and the Chief Information Officer of the Commonwealth, Nelson Moe, respectfully submits this report pursuant to <u>Item 92(D)</u> of the 2021 Appropriation Act, which provides:

"The Chief Information Officer and the Secretary of Administration shall provide the Governor and the Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees with a report detailing any amendments or modifications to the information technology infrastructure services contracts. The report shall include statements describing the fiscal impact of such amendments or modifications and shall be submitted within 30 days following the signing of any amended agreement."

In addition to this formal report, VITA continues to report to policymakers in detail on the IT infrastructure services contracts and platform through executive reporting and through Committee and Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission (JLARC) staff.
