II. Actions taken in compliance with §23.1-1301. Public access to information.

The goal of the Board of Visitors of Radford University is to operate in a transparent manner as contemplated in §23.1-1301 as evidenced by the following:

1) Held Quarterly Board Meetings on the following dates all of which were open to the public, notice was provided pursuant to §2.2-3707 of the Code of Virginia, and the agendas and minutes were published pursuant to state law: February 12, 2021; April 23, 2021; September 10, 2021; and December 3, 2021.

2) Held a Board Retreat on August 8-10, 2021. All three days were open to the public, notice was provided pursuant to \$2.2-3707 of the Code of Virginia, and agenda and minutes were published pursuant to state law.

6) Radford University Board of Visitors participated in a Presidential Search between June and December 2021. The Rector named a 23-person committee with Board of Visitors members as Chair and Co-chair. Six Board members served on the Search Committee, which met June 21, 2021; October 12, 2021; October 23-24, 2021; and November 15, 2021.

The Board of Visitors met on November 15, 2021 and December 6-7, 2021 in special meetings to prepare, interview and select the eighth president.

All meetings were held in accordance with the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and an attorney from the Office of the Attorney General was present at all meetings.

III. Actions taken in compliance with §23.1-1303 Boards of Visitors; Bylaws.

IV. Actions taken in compliance with §23.1-1303 Boards of Visitors; Annual meeting with the president of the institution.

Pursuant to §23.1-1303 and in accordance with the Bylaws of the Board of Visitors of Radford University, the Board does meet annually with the President concerning his review.

President Brian O. Hemphill provided data and benchmarks regarding performance for the 2020-2021 academic year at the April 23, 2021 Executive Committee and Board meetings. Strategies and outcomes were discussed.

V. Actions taken in compliance with §23.1-1306 Boards of Visitors; Executive Committee

At the August 9, 2021 annual Retreat, the Board of Visitors Executive Committee reviewed the committee's responsibilities and duties, as outlined in the Code of Virginia, the Bylaws and Board practices. A recommendation was made for an update and approval of the Statement on Governance and reaffirmation of the Code of Ethics. A subcommittee was formed to review and make any recommendations for changes to the Bylaws; and the continued education recommendation was satisfied with the approval by SCHEV for the 2021 Retreat agenda meeting continued education requirement. The Board of Visitors subsequently approved the Statement on Governance and reaffirmed the Code of Ethics.

New Board of Visitors member Orientation was held on August 8, 2021, prior to the annual Retreat for the three new members.
