I am writing to report on the Virginia Investment Performance (VIP) and Major Eligible Employer (MEE) grants that were awarded during the first quarter of the 2022 calendar year as required by 2.2-5103(D) of the <u>Code of Virginia</u>.

In the first quarter, ending March 31, 2022, four VIP grants were awarded. No MEE grants were awarded in the first quarter of 2022.
