Report of Assets Received as a Result Of Law Enforcement Seizures/Forfeitures

The goal of the Department of State Police is to utilize asset forfeiture in carrying out the Department's mission to combat trafficking in illegal substances and criminal activity. Asset forfeiture is not a substitute for traditional law enforcement methods and techniques and at no time will seizure and forfeiture of assets take priority over criminal law enforcement. Criminal activities that come to the attention of this Department will be investigated to their fullest regardless of whether assets may be seized or the value of those assets. However, it is recognized that a criminal drug investigation must include the investigation of the accumulation of assets, as the fruits of the crime and those financial investigative techniques must be utilized to pursue this aspect of drug crimes. It is the view of the Department of State Police that asset forfeiture is remedial in nature, intended to redress the harm caused to society by those individuals who manufacture and sell illegal drugs.

In accordance to U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), U.S. Department of Treasury (DOT) and Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), at no time shall the monies received from forfeitures be used to pay salaries or to supplant an agency's normal operating budget. The funds shall be expended in accordance to established DOJ, DOT and DCJS policies to support law enforcement activities.

During the course of *Fiscal Year 2022*, the Department of State Police received **\$1,334,624.08** as a result of law enforcement seizures and subsequent forfeitures. Additionally, we were awarded in-kind assets, some of which the value is unknown. Both are listed and accounted for the follow two pages.
