## Sales Highlights

July 2022 sales were strongly supported by the Mega Millions jackpot run to over \$1.3 billion, ending on July 29<sup>th</sup> with a jackpot win in Illinois. While these sales are unusual, the Lottery and our network of over 5,300 retail partners across Virginia stay ready to handle player demand when these opportunities arise – and these sales fueled an increase in overall lottery sales commissions for those partners. iLottery sales growth continues, driven by the Lottery's overall omnichannel strategy and focus on key improvements to the customer experience.

## Profit Highlights

July 2022 profits were also strong, with the national interest and focus on the Mega Millions jackpot. Profit growth ( $\pm 26.7\%$ ) outpaced the sales growth ( $\pm 20.8\%$ ) because of the 41% increase in draw game sales, which are highly profitable products.

## Other Highlights

On Tuesday August 16, 2022, the Lottery was honored to host Secretary of Education Aimee Guidera as we announced our \$779 million in profits generated during FY22 for education in Virginia. These record profits resulted from the Lottery's continued commitment to providing games that appeal to a wide range of adult players, delivered in a secure manner where every ticket has a fair chance to win, all while focusing on delivering a positive player experience. Lottery employees who joined the check presentation ceremony appreciated hearing directly from Secretary Guidera that our commitment to being best-in-class with an important mission does not go unnoticed.
