### Sales Highlights

January activity was supported by yet another multi-state jackpot run, this time with Mega Millions rolling to \$1.38 billion, with one winning ticket sold in Maine. Retail sales were stronger than last January, due in part to the jackpot roll and because last January retail activity was significantly affected by several weather events. For FY23, total sales are more than 9% ahead of the official forecast, primarily from the unprecedented Mega Millions and Powerball jackpots, with three separate runs topping \$1 billion. Year-over-year comparison shows sales up more than 20% over last year. However, scratcher ticket sales, games that are sold only in retail stores, are down 8% compared to last year.

#### **Profit Highlights**

Profits for the month and the year-to-date were very strong. January profits, with the strong sales in the highly profitable Mega Millions game, were nearly \$20 million ahead of the month's forecast. We are on a solid track to meet the profit transfers expected in the budget for the current fiscal year, as anticipated by the Conference Report passed by the House and Senate. Any surplus will become part of the total transfers available in the Lottery Proceeds Fund for FY24.

#### Other Highlights

The Lottery continues with its "best-in-class" offerings for players by introducing two new features. We are the first in the industry to launch mobile cashing to an online account, allowing players to cash winning retail-purchased tickets up to \$5,000 into their Lottery wallet through the Virginia Lottery mobile app. This new and secure option lets players claim prizes easily 24-hours a day, while still ensuring identity verification, tax reporting, and legally required debt setoff checks. The second new feature allows players to create a digital barcode which can be

scanned directly from their phone at any Virginia Lottery retailer to withdraw winnings from their account. This offers a convenient option for our customers while giving retailers the opportunity to earn commissions on each voucher cashed.

This work is part of the Lottery's omnichannel strategy, creating great customer experiences when and where players choose to do business with us.
