2022 ANNUAL REPORT

The Brown v. Board of Education Scholarship Program was established in 2005 in accordance with § 30-231.1 of the Code of Virginia to provide free education to students who were denied education in the public schools of Virginia between 1954 and 1964 when, in defiance of the 1954 *Brown v. Board of Education* desegregation ruling, several cities and counties closed their schools.

2021-2022 Scholarships

In the 2021–2022 academic year, two students continued to be awarded scholarships through the Brown v. Board of Education Scholarship Program, and funds were disbursed for both students. The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) disbursed funds accordingly:

By the end of the 2021–2022 academic year, the Brown v. Board of Education Scholarship Fund had awarded in total \$1,304,657.63 to 88 individual students over the course of 17 years, with \$989,185.09 remaining in the fund's balance.

Staff received only renewal applications for the 2021–2022 academic year and continued to provide scholarships to the two students already enrolled in the program.
