Sales Highlights

August highlights include the culmination of the Mega Millions national jackpot rolling to \$1.58 billion with a single winning ticket sold in Florida. Overall, cumulative sales were up 28% compared to the same period last year. Sales of iLottery Instants continue to be strong, up nearly 67% compared to last year.

Profit Highlights

August monthly profits were also impressive, up more than 35% compared to the same month last year. For the first two months of FY24, profits are 18% or \$25 million higher than last year. Retailer earnings and the overall earnings rate continue to lag compared to last year, mainly due to the timing of a new quarterly incentive program which will not be paid to retailers until the end of the first quarter.

Other Highlights

The Virginia Lottery participated in the Senate Finance & Appropriations Committee meeting earlier this month, and we continue to work closely with the Secretary of Finance as the fall revenue forecast process begins.

The Lottery also recently celebrated the 35th anniversary of the first lottery ticket sold in Virginia. The \$1 Match 3 Scratcher debuted to Virginians at midnight on September 20, 1988, and was the only ticket in the marketplace. Today the Lottery is proud to offer a wide range of products, at retail and online, from which all profits support K-12 education in the Commonwealth.
