Dear Chairs Edwards, Deeds, and Kilgore:

Virginia Code §17.1-106 requires the Office of the Executive Secretary (OES) to distribute evaluation forms for retired recalled circuit court judges during the final year of the three-year period following their qualification by the Senate Committee on the Judiciary and the House Committee for Courts of Justice. In addition, Item 42, Paragraph P of the 2023 Appropriation Act, Chapter 1, Special Session I requires the Office of the Executive Secretary to collect information regarding the numbers and types of cases referred to retired circuit court judges. This letter serves to report the results of these activities to the Senate Committee on the Judiciary and the House Committee for Courts of Justice. This process is not part of the Judicial Performance Evaluation (JPE) Program, which is established in Virginia Code § 17.1-100 and the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia.

On October 2, 2023, OES distributed a survey to evaluate a group of eight retired recalled judges in their final year of the three-year period following their qualification, and to collect information about the number and types of cases referred to retired circuit court judges. This survey was designed in Survey Monkey, an online survey tool. A survey announcement was sent via email to all active members of the Virginia State Bar (VSB). Lawyers who appeared before or observed any retired circuit court judge in the past 12 months were asked to complete the anonymous survey using the survey link provided in the email. Lawyers who were ineligible (i.e., had not appeared before or observed a retired judge in the past 12 months) were to disregard the survey. A follow-up survey announcement was sent to all active members of the VSB on October 16. The survey closed on October 31.

The survey to evaluate retired recalled judges in the final year of their qualification measured the frequency (i.e., rarely/never, about half the time, frequently/always) of various attributes of the judges observed over a twelve-month period, including timeliness, respect, attentiveness, communication, and knowledgeability. Upon completion of the survey, lawyers certified that they had not completed more than one survey response for a particular judge and that the responses were based on their personal experience with the judge. Also included on the survey was a question asking the case type(s) in which the attorney appeared before or observed the retired recalled judge. Lawyers who responded that they had not appeared before one of the eight listed retired circuit judges but had appeared before any retired circuit judge during the past 12 months also answered this question.

In total, 2,702 respondents completed the survey - 561 respondents for the eight retired recalled judges being evaluated and 2,141 respondents who appeared before or observed any retired judge. Thirty-nine (7%) of the 561 respondents for the specific retired recalled judges had appeared before or observed a particular judge more than 5 times. Overall, "frequently/always" was entered for 83%-93% of responses across all the evaluation questions. The results indicate that the eight retired recalled circuit court judges are convening court without undue delay, using courtroom time efficiently, and are prompt in rendering clear decisions frequently or always. Across all evaluation areas, the eight judges exhibited the assessed characteristics "rarely/never" in less than 2% of responses. Individual survey results for each retired recalled judge are attached in alphabetical order by last name.

Of survey responses noting the case type(s) in which the attorney appeared before or observed a retired circuit court judge, results indicate that 62% (1,506/2,428) of the cases were civil in nature. Civil case types included on the survey were domestic relations, tort, contract, and other civil. Criminal case type was a stand-alone selection and counted for 38% (922/2,428) of the cases in which the survey respondents appeared before or observed retired judges. A report detailing case type responses is also attached.

Statistically, case filings and types are not tracked for retired judges. Retired judges served for 3,057 days over the 12-month period, September 1, 2022-August 31, 2023.
