## December Highlights

Sales and profits were both stronger than last December, with both metrics moving at nearly the same 18% increase. Scratcher sales declined again in December, but draw game sales were supported by the growth of the Powerball jackpot that was eventually won at \$842M on New Year's Day. Holiday seasonal sales were supported at our valued retail partners across Virginia, through holiday marketing campaigns and retailer incentives focused on product availability.

#### Year to Date Highlights

For the first half of the fiscal year, iLottery Instants continue to experience strong growth in the fourth year of availability. Though retail sales activity continued to lag the prior year, the decline was less significant in December as more skill games were disabled in the market. Overall profits are up more than 6% compared to last year and are tracking ahead of the updated forecast included in your introduced budget.

# Other Highlights

We are monitoring legislation during the 2024 Session, including many proposals related to the regulation of skill games, casino gaming, and illegal gambling coordination efforts. Amidst this busy legislative season, we look forward to highlighting the Lottery's important mission of supporting K-12 public education by awarding our three newest Thank a Teacher Art Contest winners with surprise presentations in Roanoke, York and Fauquier in early March. If schedules permit, we'd be honored to have you or members of the administration join us.
